## **Student Field Trip Responsibilities**

All field trips are a privilege for students and must therefore be earned. With this in mind, it is necessary for Marvin Ridge Middle School to enact a discipline policy regarding the Washington DC trip to be taken on March 13-16<sup>th</sup>, 2019. This policy can also be found at <a href="https://www.mrmsdc2019.weebly.com">www.mrmsdc2019.weebly.com</a>. If students cannot meet discipline requirements then they will be removed from the field trip. If removed, a student/parent will lose all monies paid for the trip and the student will not be permitted to attend the trip.

All trip deposits are non-refundable. Checks can be made out to MRMS.

The following rules are in place to ensure that only responsible students are rewarded with a great trip:

- 1. Students who earn <u>1 or more Out-of-School Suspensions</u> will be removed from the trip. (Administrative panel will determine actual trip removal based on the OSS)
- 2. Students who earn 3 or more In-School Suspensions will be removed from the trip.
- 3. Students who earn <u>5 or more After School detentions or 5 Related Arts detentions</u> will be removed from the trip.

\*\*Please note that if a student misbehaves on the actual trip, that it is within Marvin Ridge Middle School's authority to either fly a student home or send a student home via other modes of transportation. If this should happen, all cost will be incurred by parents who gave permission for their student to attend the trip. \*\*

## Medication

- Students who take medication of <u>ANY</u> kind (this includes Ibuprofen, aspirin, acetaminophen and all over the counter products), must have this information on file with the school nurse. Students and parents can obtain this form from the school nurse. Parents must provide the school nurse with the actual medication, which will be distributed to teachers attending the field trip to give to students at designated times per the health form.
- A doctor's note is required along with the medical form for <u>ALL</u> medication, even over the counter.
- Students are <u>NOT</u> allowed to carry any of their own medication, with the exception of self-carry inhalers and epi-pens that have been filed with the school nurse. The medical form and medication is due to the school nurse by the Friday, Friday, February 15, 2019.

If there are any medical issues that occur past this deadline, it is the responsibility of students and parents to provide the school nurse with this information. Friday, February 15, 2019 is the last day to turn in any medical information and/or medicine. Exceptions will be made in emergency situations only.
